St. Bonaventure University alumna Carol Schumacher of Rogers has been named to the board of trustees at her alma mater. She is serving a three-year term.

Schumacher is the new head of corporate affairs at Intercontinental Exchange, parent company of the New York Stock Exchange and is based in Atlanta. She previously served as the global investor relations officer for Wal-Mart Stores, Inc. for more than a decade. She previously also led corporate affairs for Kerr-McGee Corporation and public relations for The Home Depot.

Schumacher graduated from St. Bonaventure in 1978 with a degree in journalism and earned a master's degree in communications from Rowan University.

She served as a member of St. Bonaventure's National Alumni Board from 1988 to 1996, including service as board president from 1994 to 1996, and was honored as Alumna of the Year in 1998. She is a current member of the School of Journalism and Mass Communication Advisory Council.
